TECHNIGRAPHICS EXPANDS IN FORT COLLINS

In a visit to Northern Colorado, Dee Vaidya, President and Chief Executive Officer of TechniGraphics, announced the company's intentions to expand its operation in Fort Collins, CO. In a move to accommodate additional growth, TechniGraphics purchased a 35,500 square foot building in southeast Fort Collins located at 3351 Eastbrook Drive in May of 2006. The company renovated the building and moved in to its new quarters in March, 2007, with plans to expand its employee base by 10% this year, with an additional 100 employees by 2010.

TechniGraphics is a multinational corporation that specializes in data capture, data management and information visualization solutions in the fields of geospatial technology (GIS) and product lifecycle management (PLM).

The firm started out in 1982 as Technicolor Graphic Services (TGS), a division of the "Color by Technicolor" company. It began working with early GIS systems and has progressed with the maturing industry to become a leader in geospatial technology. The company's federal customers include the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency and Department of Homeland Security.

Last year TechniGraphics made three acquisitions that also established it as a leader in the 3-Dimensional Computer Aided Design (CAD) field with the CATIA, ENOVIA and DELMIA suite of software used by large manufacturers and their supply chains for Product Lifecycle Management. Among TechniGraphics' industrial customers are world renowned names like Bell Helicopter, Boeing, DaimlerChrysler, General Dynamics, Lockheed Martin, Northrop Grumman and Oshkosh Truck. TechniGraphics provides PLM software, implementation, training, support and engineering services to these multinationals.

Headquartered in Wooster, Ohio, TechniGraphics now has domestic facilities in California, Colorado, Georgia, Michigan, Missouri and Washington. International locations include India and the Netherlands. With the addition of the new Fort Collins facility, TechniGraphics is well positioned to take advantage of the growth in the technology industry in Northern Colorado.

According to Dee Vaidya, "Northern Colorado provides great access to the kind of talent that TechniGraphics needs to grow, because we are an innovative company that values creative individuals interested in working in a dynamic, high growth atmosphere."

TechniGraphics has a well educated, relatively young, employee base. "We are excited to have been working with TechniGraphics," said Maury Dobbie, President and CEO of the Northern Colorado Economic Development Corporation. "They are a great example of a growing technology company that is creating new jobs and investing in Northern Colorado", she added. The NCEDC has been working with TechniGraphics since late 2005.
